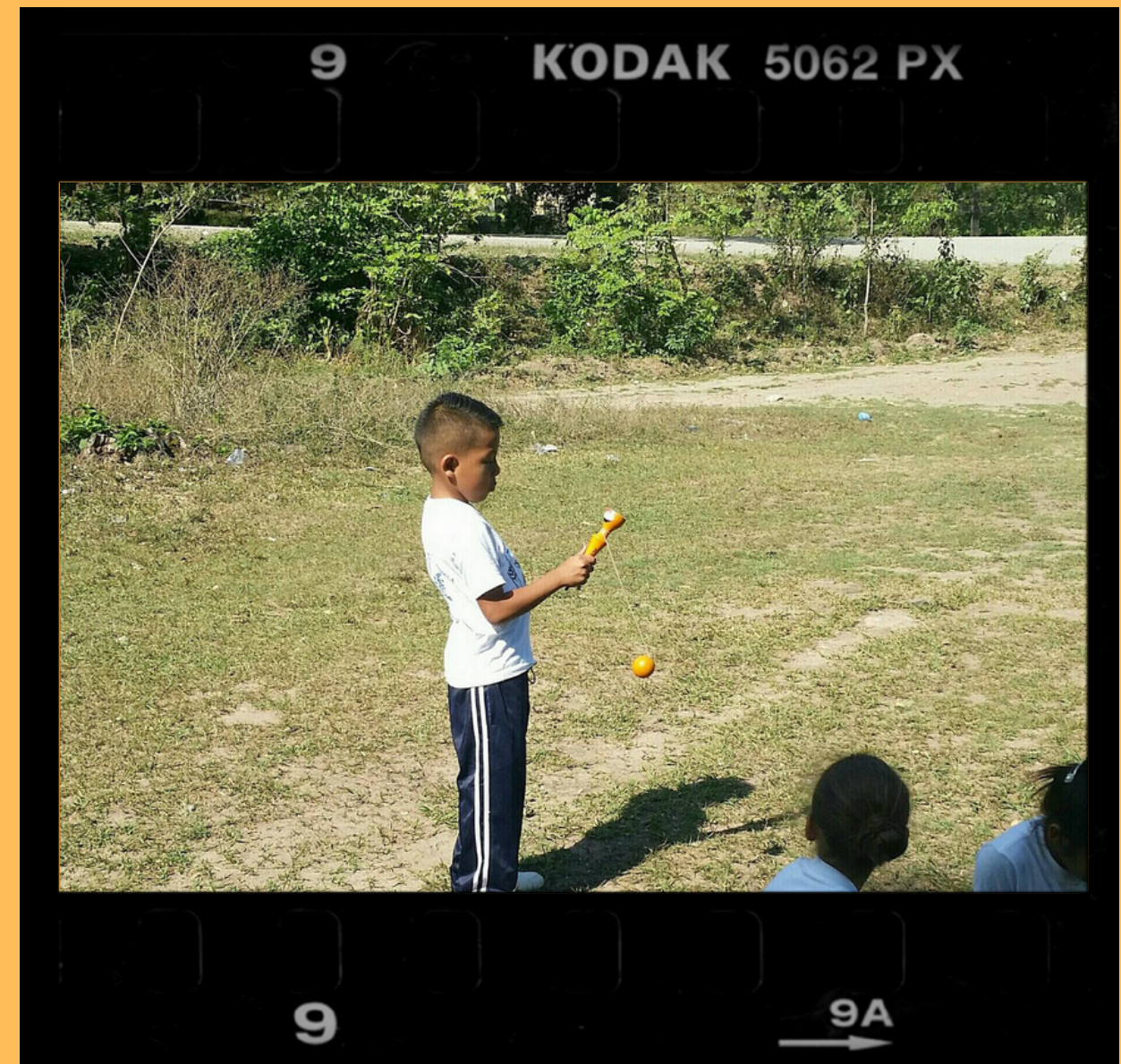

Sports Boxes: a pedagogical tool





Sport boxes contain sports equipment to be used by the teachers during sports class or during recess periods. They carry the necessary equipment for group games.



The sports boxes also contain traditional games to keep Honduran children's traditions alive.

Weekly sports classes in the network of rural schools





Every week the sports teacher from Honduras Rising visits the schools to teach a sport class during school hours. Three sports are alternated during the year: soccer, ultimate and volleyball.

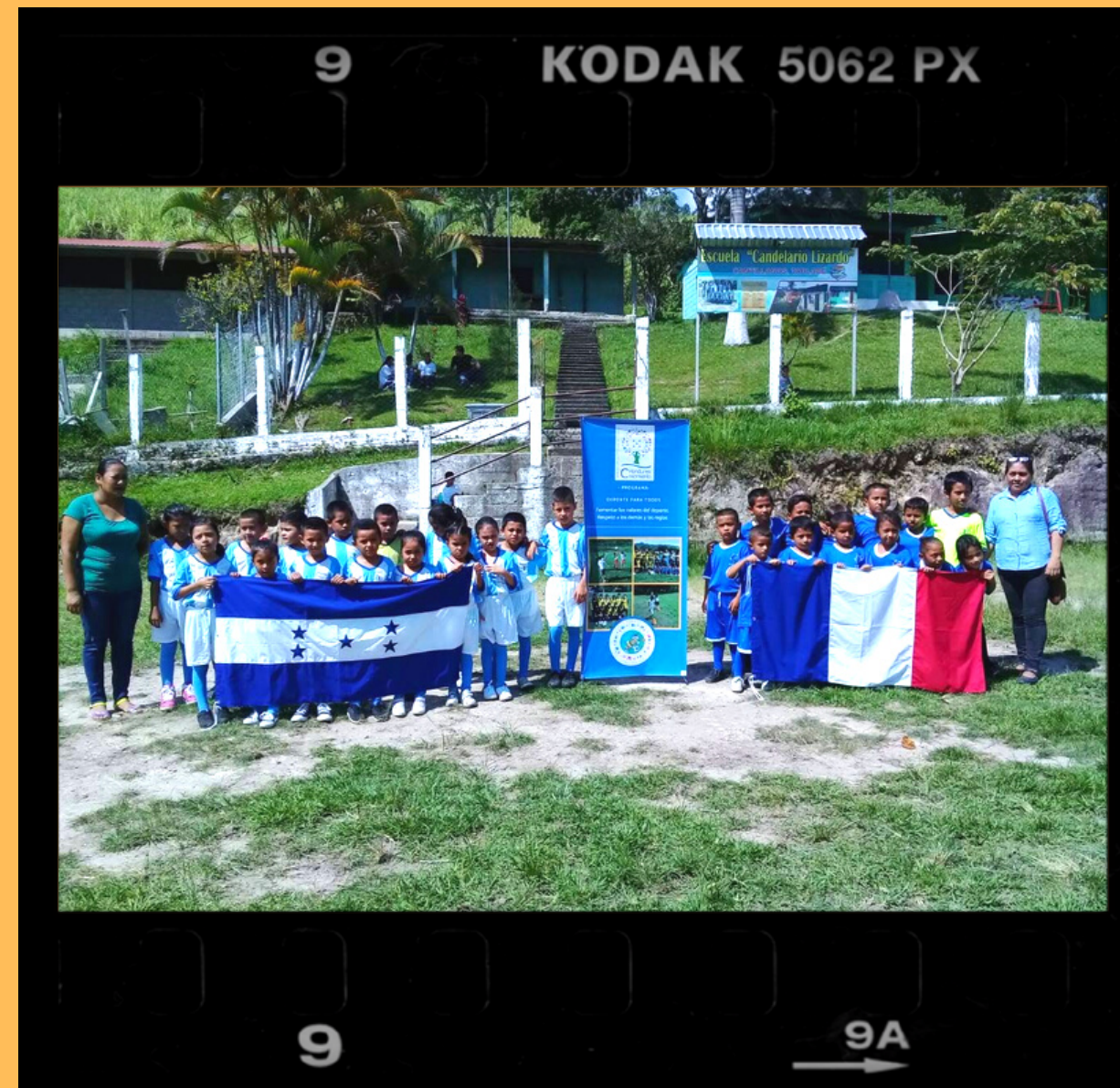
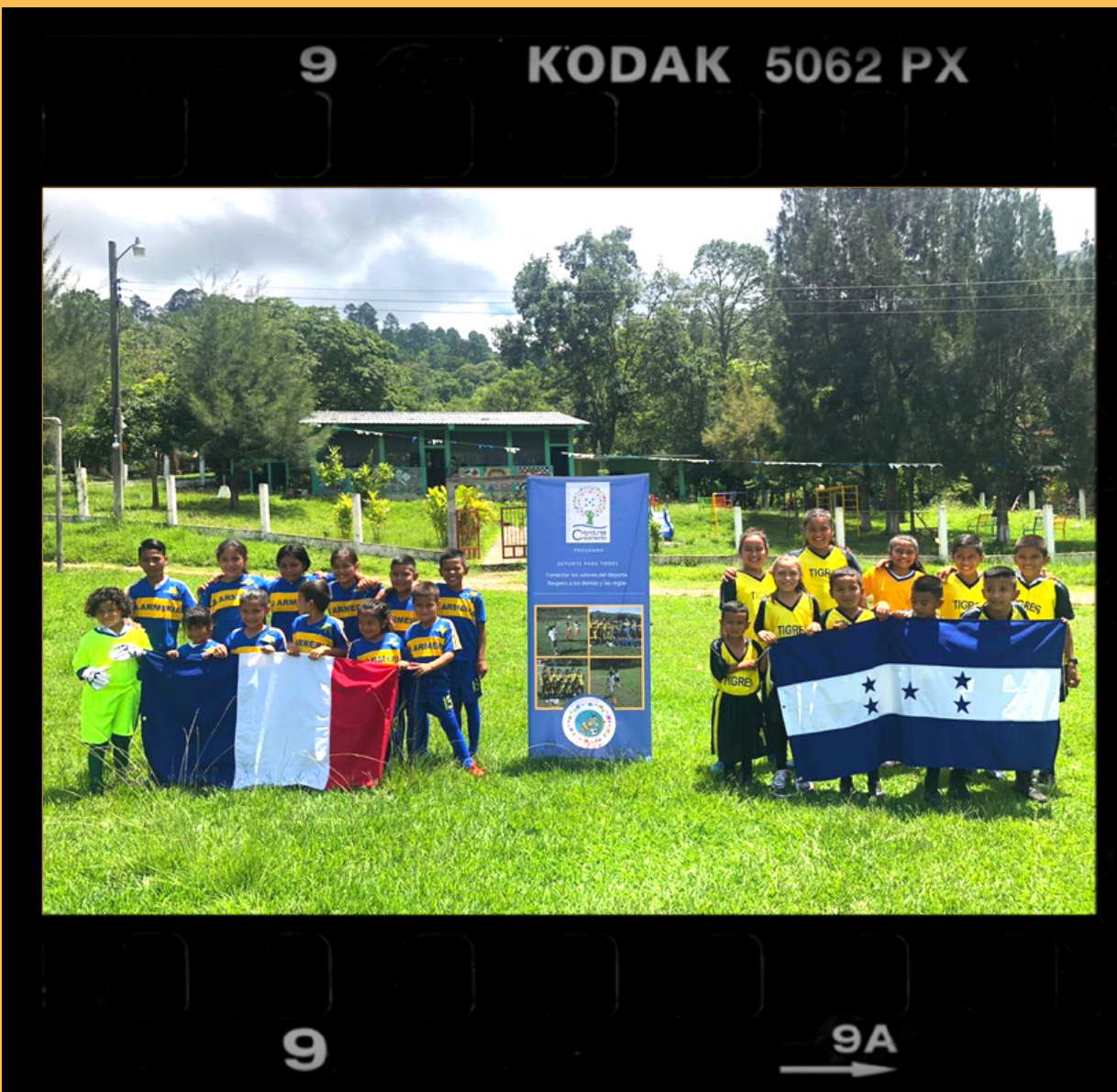




Girls are a priority in the program, accounting for 30% of enrollment annually.

The championships: the most anticipated moment



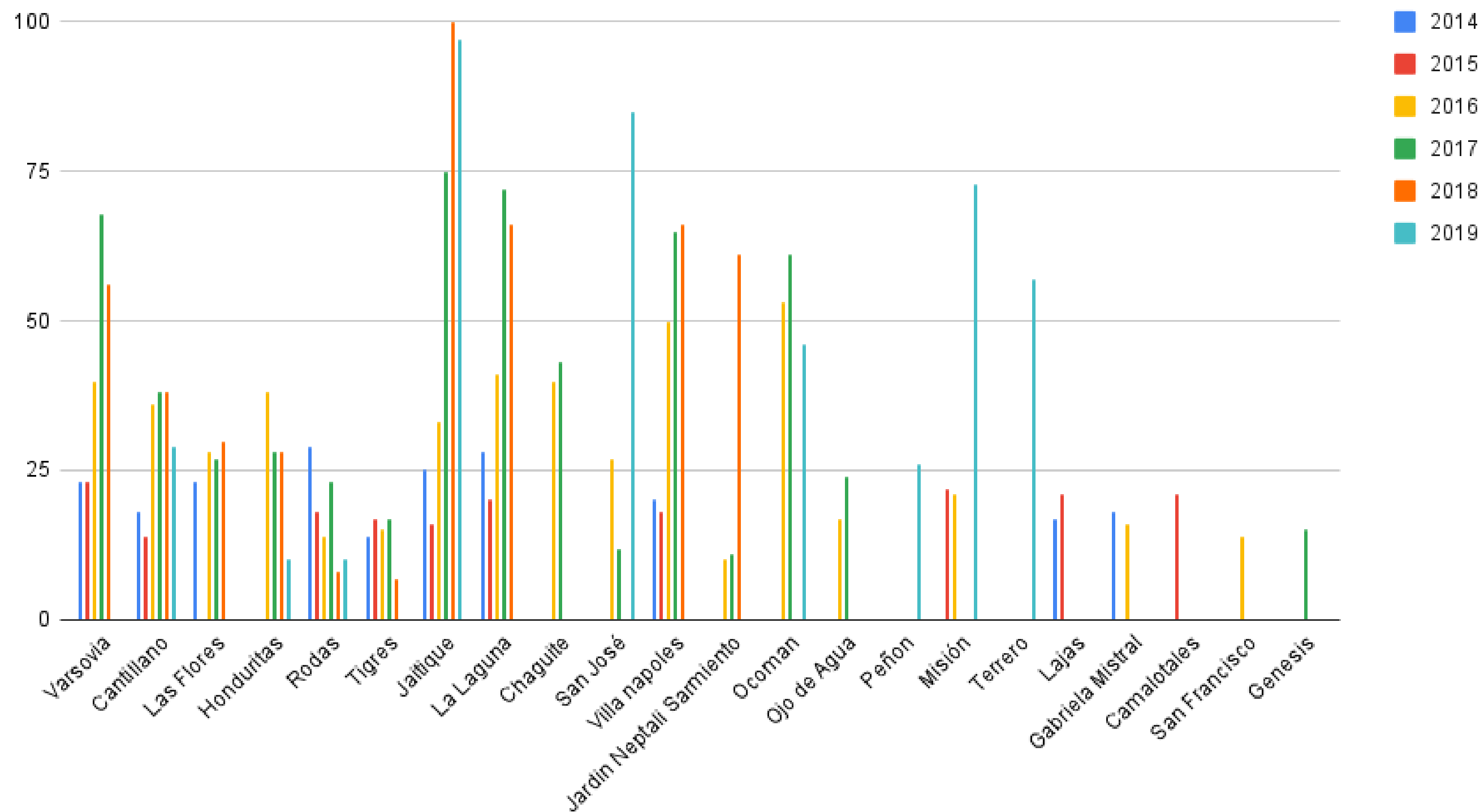


Sports for All organizes every year a championship with all the schools of the program. This allows interaction among children from different rural communities; it is highly anticipated by all students.,

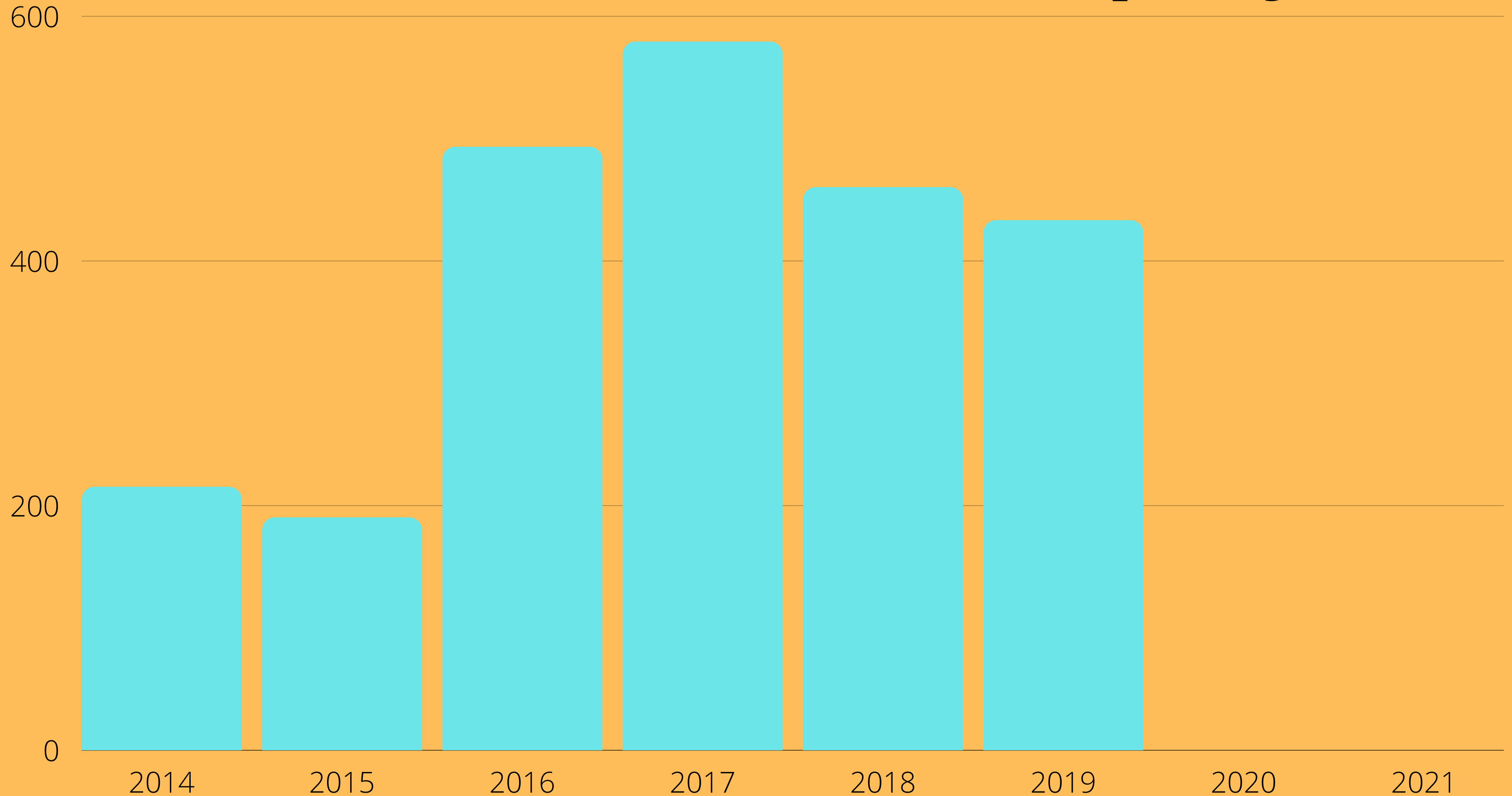
